

Right now, they will start their outreach in Bluefields then go to Corn Island a place near Bluefields and make their way to Juigalpa another city in Nicaragua as they move towards Managua the capital. Once they get to Managua their vision is to travel to Europe and then to Mozambique. I don't know if you have heard of the cyclone that happened in East Africa but Mozambique is a country that was heavily affected. The DTS has a big financial need to be able to go but are traveling to Managua in faith believing that the finances will arrive and they can help in the relief efforts there.
